What is "*Cost of Attendance*"

Using the Department of Education's guidelines, MTSA's Financial Aid Office (FAO) will determine the Cost of Attendance (COA) for each student. The COA is the total amount of money a student will need to attend school for one year. It includes tuition, fees, books, supplies, room and board, and other expenses.
